

Council Highlights – September 15, 2026

The meeting took place at the Township of South-West Oxford's Municipal office at 6:30 p.m. A summary of the happenings from Council is as follows:

Delegations and Appointments:

- **Kevin Paton - Development Charges**
 - Kevin Paton presented to Council regarding the development charges associated with his Additional Residential Unit (ARU). The CAO also provided a report to Council on ARU Development Charges.
- **Philip Bradley, WalterFedy and Jeff Johnston, Sierra Contracting**
 - CAO Julie Middleton provided a report to Council from WalterFedy regarding the GHG Emissions Analysis for the Township of South-West Oxford's New Municipal Office, Library, and, Child Care Centre. Council directed staff to proceed with the all-electric mechanical system.
- **Jillian Smith - UTRCA**
 - Mayor Mayberry and CAO Julie Middleton advised Council that the UTRCA has informed the Township that the cost for the installation of the gabion baskets at the Centreville Dam has increased. Jillian Smith from UTRCA was present to respond to any questions Council had. Council directed the CAO to review alternative options with UTRCA and report back to Council.
